

Resolution of the DNSO Registrars Constituency

Whereas, Verisign GRS has presented a proposal to create a "Wait Listing Service" (hereinafter referred to as "WLS"), and

Whereas the Registrars Constituency has both the right and the responsibility to adopt and express its position on proposals by registries to introduce new services, and

Whereas many members of the Constituency have a variety of significant concerns about this proposal as currently drafted, and

Whereas the Constituency as a body through the adoption of this resolution wishes to oppose the implementation of WLS, and

Whereas the Constituency believes that the denial of permission by ICANN for the introduction of WLS would be reasonable, and

Whereas ICANN, through its contract with Verisign GRS, may withhold permission for the introduction of a new registry services provided that this permission is not withheld unreasonably, be it therefore

Resolved that the DNSO Registrars Constituency opposes the implementation of WLS, and be it further

Resolved that this opposition be the official position of this Constituency until such time as this position is revised by vote of the Constituency, and be it further

Resolved that the DNSO Registrars Constituency urges ICANN to withhold permission for the implementation of WLS, and be it further

Resolved that the Executive Committee of the Registrar Constituency is directed to communicate this position to Verisign GRS, to ICANN and to any other interested parties.
